Les Enfants Terribles

Performed in Japanese

“Les Enfants Terribles,” a 1929 novel by the great French poet, novelist and playwright Jean Cocteau (1889-1963) about a young brother and sister’s ill-fated lives is among the avant-garde artist’s leading works, with critics often comparing it to a great classical tragedy.

For this production, the leading dramatist Seiji Nozoe has written the script based on a translation of Cocteau’s original work he has adapted for the stage with the play’s director, Akira Shirai, the artistic director of Kanagawa Arts Theatre.

Nozoe has been well known as a playwright, director and actor at his Tokyo theatre company Haegiwa (Hairline) since 1999, and in 2012 he won the prestigious 56th Kishida Kunio Drama Award with his play “〇〇toaru Fukei” (“A Landscape called 〇〇”). He is also active acting, directing and working as a scenario writer in movies and television.

For Akira Shirai, who directs “Les Enfants Terribles,” this production marks his first collaboration with Nozoe.
