With “Knife,” the founder of Tokyo’s “Derasinera” mime-dance troupe, Shuji Onodera, has created a new multinational collaboration work for KAAT in which his company’s members are joined by a range of dancers including Nung Van Minh from Vietnam, Juichu Liu from Taiwan, French-resident Akiko Kajihara and Dakei, a deaf Butoh artist.

In this piece, Onodera aims to present the peculiar, amusing world behind many of our hectic daily lives as he allows the dancers’ multi-cultural backgrounds to stimulate his imagination even in these difficult times for the creation of international works.
